T1.1 TENDER NOTICE AND INVITATION TO TENDER

The Sundays River Valley Municipality invites tenders for the **AUGMENTATION OF BULK AND DISTRIBUTION WATER INFRASTRUCTURE TO THE VILLAGES OF ENON AND BERSHEBA**

Tenderers must have a CIDB contractor grading designation of **6CE** or higher. Tenderers attention is drawn to clause 4.1.1 of the Tender Data when submitting their tender. Tenders from tenderers with a CIDB contractor grading designation of **5 CE PE** or lower will not be accepted. In addition, tenderers must demonstrate competence in the construction of projects using the principles of the Extended Public Works Programme either through their own experience or through a joint venture partner.

The project is subject to the new PPPFA Regulations of 2017 whereby a minimum of 30% of the value of the works must be let out to Exempt Micro Enterprises (EMEs) or Qualifying Small Enterprises (QSEs) which are at least 51% owned by black people (sub-clause 9.(1) (b)) and who are registered on the Sundays River Valley Municipality's database to meet the requirements of the "stipulated minimum threshold" (sub-clause 8.1 (b)). In addition, all unskilled and semi-skilled labour must be sourced from within the SRVM boundaries.

In addition, only tenderers who have access to a suitably qualified and experienced construction manager (Contracts Representative) who will be the single point accountability and responsibility for the management of the construction works, and who is registered with SACPCMP as PrCM or with ECSA as PrEng or PrTechEng are eligible to tender.

Preferences are offered to tenderers in terms of sub-clause 5.11.8 of the Tender Data.

Only tenderers who are registered on the Sundays River Valley Municipality database and the Central Supplier Database (CSD) as accredited service providers are eligible to submit tenders. Registration is permitted prior to the submission of tenders

A non-refundable tender deposit of **R 300,00** payable in cash or by bank guaranteed cheque made out in favour of the Employer, is required on collection of the tender documents.

A compulsory clarification meeting with representatives of the Employer and the Employers Agent will take place at the Bersheba Community Hall, in Bersheba Location, Latitude: 33°24'40.95"S Longitude: 25°32'49.17"E on **Monday 29th October 2018** starting at **10h00am**. Thereafter, the tenderers will be taken on an inspection of the site. Attendance and completion of the attendance register(s) is compulsory for all Tenderers. Please note that **NO** attendees arriving more than **15 minutes** late will be allowed to attend the clarification meeting.

The closing time for receipt of tenders is 12h00pm on **Friday 9th November 2018** at **SRVM Supply Chain Management Unit, No. 26 Mark Street, Kirkwood**.

Telegraphic, telephonic, telex, facsimile, postal and late tenders will not be accepted.

Tenderers must take particular note of the following:

- It is an express condition of this Contract that a minimum of 30% of the value of the works must be let out to Exempt Micro Enterprises (EMEs) or Qualifying Small Enterprises (QSEs) which are at least 51% owned by black people (sub-clause 9.(1) (b)) and who are registered on the Sundays River Valley Municipality's database to meet the requirements of the "stipulated minimum threshold" (sub-clause 8.1 (b)). Further, this work is to be subcontracted in a minimum of 15 work packages to EMEs / QSEs registered in the

appropriate CE grading for the value of the subcontracted works tendered (the majority of EMEs / QSEs will be CE1s).

In addition, all unskilled and semi-skilled labour must be sourced from within the SRVM boundaries.

- Only tenderers complying with the requirements as specified in the Conditions of Tender and Tender Data will be considered.
- **Functionality:** Tender offers will only be considered responsive if the minimum Functionality requirement of 70% is achieved.
- Tenderers are therefore required to meet a minimum functionality score of 35 points out of 50 based on the criteria listed in the Tender data No. 22 (Clause 5.8)

- The 80/20 preference point system will be applicable with 80 points allocated to Price and 20 points towards B-BBEE Status Level of Contribution for projects under R50m, and 90/10 with 90 points allocated to Price and 10 points towards B-BBEE Status Level of Contribution for projects over R50m.

Requirements for sealing, addressing, delivery, opening and assessment of tenders are stated in the Tender Data.

Tenders may only be submitted on the tender documentation that is issued.

The following compulsory documents must be included in the tender documents:

1. Valid Tax Clearance Certificate OR Status Pin
2. B-BBEE Certificate original or certified copy
3. Certified ID Copies of Company Director(s)
4. Completed MBD forms – 1, 4, 6.1, 8 & 9
5. Company registration Documents
6. Municipal statement of Rates, Billing Clearance not older than three months or Lease Agreement
7. Suppliers must be registered on National Treasury Centralised Supplier Database

The lowest or any tender will not necessarily be accepted, and the Municipality reserves the right to accept a tender as a whole or in part. Telegraphic, telephonic, telex, facsimile, e-mail, posted and late tenders will not be accepted. More requirements for sealing, addressing, delivery, opening and assessment of tenders are stated in the Tender Data.

The council promotes the use of EMEs and QSEs. For further details refer to the tender and contract sections of the Tender Document.
