 UPGRADING OF THE SEWER NETWORK IN ADDO**

**TENDER NOTICE AND INVITATION TO TENDER**

The Sundays River Valley Municipality invites tenders for the Upgrading of the sewer network in Addo.

The scope of works under this project includes:

- Remove and install new 250mmø sewer pipelines (770m);
- Remove existing 110mm and install new 160mmø sewer pipelines(700m);
- Install new 200mm diameter lines to acceptable grades (1340m);
- Construction of new manholes (78No);
- Repairs/ Rehabilitation of existing manholes (308No); and
- Ancillary works

It is estimated that Tenderers should have a CIDB contractor grading designation of 6CE or higher.

- **Functionality:** Tender offers will only be considered responsive if the minimum Functionality requirement of 70% is achieved. Tenders will be evaluated based on the following two stages, namely:

The 80/20 preference point system will be applicable with 80 points allocated to Price and 20 points towards B-BBEE Status Level of Contribution for projects under R50m, and 90/10 with 90 points allocated to Price and 10 points towards B-BBEE Status Level of Contribution for projects over R50m.

Only tenderers who are registered on the Sundays River Valley Municipality database and the Central Supplier Database (CSD) as accredited service providers are eligible to submit tenders. Registration is permitted prior to submission of tenders.

The physical address for collection of tender documents is SRVM Cashier Office, NG Kerk, Mark Street, Kirkwood.

Documents may be collected during working hours after 08:00 on Friday, **19 October 2018**.

A non-refundable tender deposit of R500.00, five hundred rand payable (by bank guaranteed cheque or cash) to the Sundays River Valley Municipality is required on collection of the tender documents. Tenders may only be collected between 08:00 and 15:30 during weekdays.

A compulsory clarification meeting with representatives of the Employer and the Engineer will take place at the Valencia Community Hall, in Valencia Location; Latitude: 33°33'21"S, Longitude: 24°41'38"E on **Tuesday, 23 October 2018** starting at **10:00** where all the contractual and tendering aspects of the documents will be explained followed by a site inspection and an explanation of the technical requirements of the Contract. Attendance and completion of the attendance register is compulsory for all Tenderers. Tenderers must appear on the attendance register to be considered as being present. Note that Tenderers who are more than 15 minutes late for the meeting will not be allowed to attend the meeting and will not be allowed to sign the attendance register.

The closing time for receipt of tenders is **12:00 on Friday, 9 November 2018**. Tenders must be enclosed in sealed envelopes, bearing the applicable tender heading and reference number, as well as the closing time and due date.

Tenders must be submitted in the MUNICIPAL TENDER BOX situated at SRVM Supply Chain Management Unit, 26 Mark **Street, Kirkwood** Tenders will be opened in public strictly at **12:00** at the address stated above.

Tenders will be opened simultaneously at the address stated above. A tender must remain valid for a period of 90 days from the closing date for the submission of tenders. The lowest or any tender will not necessarily be accepted, and the Municipality reserves the right to accept a tender as a whole or in part. Telegraphic, telephonic, telex, facsimile, e-mail, posted and late tenders will not be accepted. Tenders may only be submitted on the tender documentation that is issued. More requirements for sealing, addressing, delivery, opening and assessment of tenders are stated in the Tender Data.
